BRIDGE TO HEALTH CARE

TCC's health care bridge curriculum provides a strong academic foundation in math, language arts, and anatomy and physiology. This course work will give you the opportunity to gain experience in laboratory and clinical settings to help prepare you to enter an Associate of Applied Science program in Nursing, Diagnostic Medical Sonography, EMS, Health Information Management, Medical Laboratory Technology, Occupational Therapy Assistant, Physical Therapist Assistant, Radiography, or Respiratory Therapy. You can also prepare to earn a Career Studies Certificate in Nurse Aide. Prepare to become a competitive applicant to one of these programs with just four to six months of instruction, three nights a week.

Admission to this program is limited to those who have completed a clinical medical assistant (CMA) program or have prior experience with phlebotomy.
